THE PUBLICATION OF THESIS OF REPORTS

As a result of the conference, collections of abstracts of conference participants will be published. Thesis of reports are accepted until December 1, 2021.

Indicating the sections that meet the following requirements:

REQUIREMENTS FOR THESIS OF REPORTS / REPORTS

In the upper-right corner, the author's full name, without abbreviations, position, name of the University, faculty, organization in full, without abbreviations; contact information: E-mail, phone number.

Main text:

Font: Times New Roman, font size 14, the interval is a multiplier of 1.3.

Paragraph indent - 1.25 cm.

Margins: top — 2 cm, bottom — 2 cm, left — 2.5 cm, right — 2.5 cm

Abstract and keywords:

Short abstract is required (from 240 characters with spaces), up to 5 keywords in Russian and English.

The height of the font in the annotation and key words 12.

The interval in the annotation and keywords is a multiplier of 1.15.

The margin after the annotation is 8 points

Footnotes:

The font height in footnotes is 11.

Footnotes are placed on a page-by-page basis, and footnotes are numbered continuously.

Bibliography:

The font height in the bibliography is 13.

The interval in the bibliography is a multiplier of 1.15.

Tables. Each table should have a short title, which consists of the word "Table", its sequence number and name. Table header format: right-aligned, font size 12, italic.

Table text format: font size 11, table cells are justified.

General alignment of the table: in the centre; size is justified.

Volume:

The volume of the article should be from 6 thousand printed characters with spaces (from 3 pages) to 24 thousand printed characters with spaces (8-12 pages).

The original text of reports (thesis of reports) must be at least 80 %.
